

Guest Lecture on “ANTI RAGGING” Delivered by Principal Dr. S. K. Pol

Venue:- SEMINAR HALL, APPASAHEB JEDHE COLLEGE

On 03/08/2016 guest lecture came to be conducted on “ANTI Ragging” for the students of College at the SEMINAR HALL of APPASAHEB JEDHE COLLEGE at about 11:30 am. The lecture was delivered by the Principal of the College Shri. Dr. S. K. Pol in presence of the students. Shri. Dr. S. K. Pol narrated as to what constitutes ragging and actions to be taken by the head of the institution.

First of all he started explaining about Ragging. Ragging is the term used for the so-called "initiation ritual" practiced in higher education institutions in South Asian countries, including India, Pakistan, Bangladesh and Sri Lanka. Ragging involves abuse, humiliation or harassment of new entrants or junior students by their senior students. It often takes a malignant form wherein the newcomers may be subjected to psychological or physical torture. Highly reputed Indian colleges have a history of ragging especially Medical colleges. It has become increasingly unpopular due to several complaints of serious injury to the victims and stringent laws pertaining to ragging. Ragging is now defined as an act that violates or is perceived to violate an individual student's dignity. Following Supreme Court orders, a National Anti Ragging Helpline was launched by the Indian Government.

A high-level committee in 2009, which probed the death of Aman Kachroo, revealed that alcohol was the main reason leading to serious form of ragging and violence in the campus. The Hon'ble Supreme Court directed the H.R.D. Ministry of the Govt. of India to form a panel which will suggest guidelines to control ragging.

In 2009, in the wake of Aman Kachroo's death, University Grants Commission (UGC) passed UGC REGULATION ON CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, 2009. These regulations mandate every college responsibilities to curb the menace of ragging, including strict pre-emptive measures, like lodging freshers in a separate hostel, surprise raids especially at nights by the

Anti-ragging squad and submission of affidavits by all senior students and their parents taking oath not to indulge in ragging.

Thereafter Shri. Dr. S. K. Pol described as to how Ragging constitutes by the acts of the student to any other student by giving following examples:

- (i) any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student;
- (ii) indulging in rowdy or in disciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student;
- (iii) asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student;
- (iv) any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;
- (v) exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- (vi) any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students;
- (vii) any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
- (viii) any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure,

- (ix) vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student ;
- (x) any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

After explaining about the term ragging he then narrated as to what action can be taken against the students who committed ragging. On receipt of the recommendation of the Anti Ragging Squad or on receipt of any information concerning any reported incident of ragging, the Head of institution shall immediately determine if a case under the penal laws is made out and if so, either on his own or through a member

of the Anti-Ragging Committee authorized by him in this behalf, proceed to file a First Information Report (FIR), within twenty four hours of receipt of such information or recommendation, with the police and local authorities, under the appropriate penal provisions provided that the Head of the institution shall forthwith report the occurrence of the incident of ragging to the District Level Anti-Ragging Committee and the Nodal officer of the affiliating University, if the institution is an affiliated institution. Provided further that the institution shall also continue with its own enquiry initiated under clause 9 of these Regulations and other measures without waiting for action on the part of the police/local authorities and such remedial action shall be initiated and completed immediately and in no case later than a period of seven days of the reported occurrence of the incident of ragging.

With that Dr. S. K. Pol finally ended his lecture and appealed the students to remove the disease of ragging from the society itself.


