































1. Happy to be associated with this institution





2. Contribution to this institution




Above diagram indicated that, 100.00 Per cent of the alumni were reported that, they were to contribute to this institution

3.The institute provides adequate facilities




Above pie Chart indicated that, over 83.3 Per cent alumni were reported, the institute provided adequate facilities where as 16.7 percent alumni were not satisfied.



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Student's Feedback Analysis - 2021-2022



1. Enjoying the Course of Choice base Credit System




Above diagram shows that, nearly 91.70% of the students were enjoying choice base credit system and only 8.30% students were reported not enjoying or not sure about choice base credit system.

2. The Syllabus completed within time limit





3. Happy with teaching tools





4. Additional Practical knowledge out of Syllabus

















8. Provide continuous co-operation and help from examination department.





1. Happy to be associated with this institution





2. Alumni contribute to institution





3. The institute provide adequate facilities





4. Associated as a life member of the alumni association





5. Experience at alumni Meetings





6. Program Syllabus preparing you for a Job or higher studies









1.Parents opinion about the infrastructure of the college

















































































- It is observed that 74.4% faculties were agree with administration motivates research activity and 17.6% faculties were partially agree with administration motivates research activity and remaining faculties were as good, disagree and excellent with administration motivates research activity.
- It is observed that 80.4% faculties were said yes satisfied with the frequency of the repair and up keep of the college facilities and 11.8% faculties were said may be Satisfied with the frequency of the repair and up keep of the college facilities and remaining faculties were said no Satisfied with the frequency of the repair and up keep of the college facilities
- It is focused that 62.7% faculties were agree with faculty room is adequate and available in the institute and 17.6% faculties were neutral with faculty room is adequate and available in the institute And 9.8% faculties were neutral with faculty room is adequate and available in the institute and remaining faculties were Good, disagree and excellent with Faculty room is adequate and available in the institute.

Suggestions:

3. Every faculty should be use ICT tools in the time of teaching.
4. Arrange infrastructure facility up to the mark.
